Readings and Reflections for this Sunday

Saints Peter and Paul are two of the great leaders of the Church in the first decades of its history, but these two apostles did not always see eye to eye. One of the challenges for the early Church was to figure out how much the followers of Christ needed to obey the provisions of the Jewish law. This became a burning issue when Gentiles started to become Christians. It was resolved in a Council at Jerusalem which said that only the very minimum was required. Paul takes this good news and energetically continues to proclaim the gospel to all. Peter is on-side, but he backs away from the Gentile Christian community when Jewish Christians are present. For Paul this is not good enough, and he criticises Peter openly. But they are both on the same side – the side of Christ! It is a very important lesson for us to see that there can be differences of opinion and different approaches in the Church. Unity is not uniformity. Catholic means allembracing.
