1925 - Kadumba House was located on a hilltop and set within one and a quarter acre of lawns and gardens overlooking the Brisbane River. For the Yeronga residents this was the closest church where they could attend mass. It stayed as the presbytery until the Sisters of St Joseph came in 1939 to use it as a convent.
